For those that cannot attend there is an online course https://www.stayexempt.irs.gov/home/starting-out/applying-section-501c3-status. For council's revenue \$50,000 or under, you may use the 1023 EZ form https://www.irs.gov/forms-pubs/about-form-1023. For council's revenue over \$50,000, you must use the 1023 form. Any council program that holds their own EIN must also file the appropriate form. These groups are also encouraged to attend the training on October 4th, 2023. You are encouraged to bring your electronic device.
